

**1 of 2 -- QUESTIONS TO פרשת דברים / parshat devarim**

1. For how many days did Moshe talk to the Jewish people? 36
2. How many days before he died did he talk to the people? 36
3. What part of the Torah is Moshe's speech? THE ENTIRE BOOK OF DEVARIM
4. Why did Moshe decide to start his speech by telling the Jews about the sins their fathers committed? SO THE SONS WOULD NOT REPEAT THEM
5. There were 600,000 men (plus women and children) listening to Moshe's speech. Obviously he couldn't talk loud enough for that many people to hear him. Who made a miracle and made his voice loud enough for everyone to hear? ה'
6. When Moshe told the Jews about the sins of their fathers, they could have said, "Why are you telling us? We didn't commit the sins!" Did they say that to Moshe? Why or why not? NO, BECAUSE THEY WERE VERY GOOD JEWS
7. After telling them about their fathers' sins, Moshe blessed the Jews that they should be as many as the what? STARS IN THE HEAVEN. He also blessed them that they should have children who are what? TZADIKIM (righteous; good Jews)
8. Moshe then told the Jews how he appointed righteous Jewish men to decide whether a person was innocent or guilty of a crime, or whether someone owed someone money or not. These men were called JUDGES
9. After Moshe explained the laws that the judges had to follow, he told the Jews about the 12 spies whom he sent to spy out Israel. How many spies brought back a good report about Israel and what were their names? TWO; YEHOShUA AND KALAIv
10. Who did the Jews believe, the ten spies or the two spies? THE TEN SPIES
11. It was bad that they believed the ten spies because ה' had promised the Jews that they would get to live in what country? ISRAEL
12. Yehoshua became the leader of the Jews. What happened to Kalaiv? HE DROVE OUT SOME GIANTS WHO WERE LIVING IN THE CITY OF CHEVRON AND HE AND HIS DESCENDANTS LIVED THERE
13. After the sin of the spies, in a place called May Meriva, the Jews complained about not having enough water. ה' told Moshe to talk to a rock and water would come out of it. He hit the rock instead. What was his punishment? HE WAS DENIED ENTRY INTO ISRAEL
14. Moshe told the fathers that their children would fight to kick out the inhabitants of Israel so they could live there. But the fathers didn't listen to him. They tried to win a war against the Emorim so they could capture Israel and live in it right away. Did the Jews win or lose the war and why? LOST, BECAUSE ה' SAID HE WOULD NOT HELP THEM
15. Name the three countries the Jews were not allowed to fight. EDOM, MO-AV, AMMON
16. Who was the king of the Emorim? SICHON
17. Name the brother of Sichon, who was the king of Bashan. OG (pronounced "Ohg")
18. Did ה' allow the Jews to kill Sichon and Og and live in their lands? YES

19. Moshe told the Jews that just like ה' killed Sichon and Og and the Jews settled in their lands, so ה' would help the Jews do what? DESTROY THE KINGS OF ISRAEL SO THE JEWS COULD LIVE IN THEIR LANDS
20. This parsha always comes on the Shabat before the Fast of Tisha B'av. The Shabat has a special name. What is it? שַׁבַּת חָזוֹן / SHABAT CHAZON
21. What does חָזוֹן / chazon mean? PROPHECY
22. Why is it called Shabat Chazon? BECAUSE THE FIRST WORD OF THE HAFTARAH IS CHAZON
