

18. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Why did this rabbi deserve death? BECAUSE HE ALSO HAD TO DO WHAT THE BIG JEWISH COURT SAID, JUST LIKE OTHER PEOPLE, AND IF EVERY JEW DID WHAT HE WANTED, THERE WOULD NOT BE ANY JEWISH RELIGION

19. As soon as the Jews captured Israel, the Torah says that they had to pick a person to rule over them. What kind of person? A KING

20. Shmuel was a prophet. What was a prophet, and do we have prophets today? SOMEONE WHO TALKED TO ה'. WE DON'T HAVE PROPHETS TODAY

21. **EXTRA CREDIT:** The Jews of Israel asked Shmuel to pick a king just like all the countries around them. Why didn't Shmuel want to give them a king even though the Torah says they had to have one? BECAUSE THE JEWS WANTED A KING LIKE NON-JEWISH COUNTRIES HAD, BUT ה' WANTED THEM TO HAVE A KING WHO WOULD RULE ACCORDING TO THE LAWS OF THE TORAH

22. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Name the first Jewish king. SHA-UL

23. The Torah says that the king had to obey certain rules. One was that he was not allowed to have too many of a certain animal. Which one? HORSES

24. What horses was he allowed to have? ONLY THOSE FOR HIS CHARIOT AND ARMY

25. What was the most number of wives a Jewish king was allowed to marry? 18

26. He was only allowed to have enough money to keep something. What? HIS ARMY

27. What did he have to write for himself? A TORAH SCROLL

28. The kohanim and levi'im had to work in the Bait Hamikdash all the time. How did they get food? THEY ATE MEAT FROM SOME OF THE SACRIFICES, AND JEWISH FARMERS GAVE THEM SOME OF THE FOOD THEY GREW

29. The Torah says not to pray to Molech, which was an idol. What did some parents do to pray to Molech, and what happened sometimes? PASS THEIR CHILDREN THROUGH TWO FIRES. SOMETIMES THE CHILDREN WERE BURNED TO DEATH

30. Some people say that a black cat passing a person means that something bad will happen to the person, or that when the 13th of a month is on a Friday, bad things will happen to people. Why don't Jews believe in these things? THEY BELIEVE THAT ה' DECIDES WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO PEOPLE

31. In the time of the Bait Hamikdash, there were six "Cities of Refuge." Who ran away to a City of Refuge, and why did he run away? A JEW WHO KILLED BY ACCIDENT. HE RAN TO ONE SO THE VICTIM'S RELATIVES WOULDN'T KILL HIM

32. Let's say you own a house. Your land is separated from your neighbor's land by a fence. What are you not allowed to do to that fence? MOVE IT SO YOU GET MORE LAND

33. (PLAY A GAME WITH YOUR CHILDREN. YOU BE THE FIRST SET OF WITNESSES, AND LET YOUR CHILDREN BE THE SECOND SET)

Two witnesses say to judges: "We saw Mr. Jones kill his neighbor Mr. Smith in our back yard at 123 Elm Street on September 18th which was a Monday at 11 o'clock at night."

The second pair of witnesses tell the judges: "You (the first witnesses) could not have seen Mr. Jones kill Mr. Smith because we saw you leave Mr. Black's house, who lives far away, at 11 o'clock."

The question is: Who do the judges believe - the first witnesses or the second witnesses? **SECOND**

34. What punishment was sometimes given to the first pair of witnesses? **THEY GOT THE PUNISHMENT THAT THEY WANTED TO SEE THE MAN GET**

35. ה' promised that when capturing Israel, the Jews should not be afraid that the Jewish soldiers would be **KILLED**

36. Three kinds of Jewish men did not have to be soldiers. One was a Jewish man who built something but didn't live in it. Built what? **A HOUSE**

37. Another man who didn't have to be a soldier was a man who planted something but didn't yet taste what grew on it. What did he plant, and what grew on it? **A VINEYARD WHERE GRAPES GROW**

38. Another man who didn't have to be a soldier was a man who just became engaged to a woman so he could get **MARRIED**

39. Before the Jewish soldiers started wars to capture cities in Israel, what did they have to do first? **ASK THE NON-JEWISH PEOPLE LIVING IN THE CITY IF THEY WANTED TO MAKE PEACE**

40. If the non-Jewish people didn't want to make peace, the Jews had to fight and beat the people. Jewish soldiers would capture men, women and children. What were the Jewish soldiers told to do to the non-Jewish people? **KILL THE MEN, BUT NOT THE WOMEN AND CHILDREN**

41. During the wars, Jewish soldiers were not allowed to destroy something that gives food. What? **FRUIT TREES**

42. Jewish soldiers were not allowed to cut down fruit trees because fruit is food. From this we learn that Jews may not waste **ANYTHING USEFUL**

43. There are many examples of wasting useful things. One is that if a Jew has any food or drink and it is not spoiled, what may the Jew not do? **THROW IT AWAY**. Another example: if a Jewish child has a toy which is not broken, what may the child not do? **BREAK IT** (throw it away). Another example: If a Jew has good clothes, what may he not do? **TEAR THEM AND THROW THEM AWAY**. And suppose a Jewish child has good school supplies such as pencils, crayons or markers. What may he not do to them? **BREAK THEM AND THROW THEM AWAY**

44. If the dead body of a man was found between two cities, and no one knew who killed him or who he was, the leaders of a city had to do some things to ask forgiveness, and to tell ה' that they didn't kill the man. Where did the leaders live? **IN THE CITY CLOSEST TO WHERE THE DEAD BODY WAS FOUND**
