

1 - QUESTIONS TO פִּרְשַׁת כִּי תָבֹא / Parshat Ki Tavo

1. In the time of the Bait Hamikdash, when a Jew saw certain kinds of foods that were ready to be picked (they were called *bikurim*, or "first fruits,") he didn't eat them. Where did he bring them? TO THE BAIT HAMIKDASH
2. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Name the seven foods that were *bikurim*. WHEAT, BARLEY, FIGS, GRAPES, POMEGRANATES, OLIVES AND DATES
3. Who did the Jewish farmer give the *bikurim* to? A KOHAIN
4. What did the Jew who brought the *bikurim* read? THE PART IN THE TORAH WHICH TALKS ABOUT BIKURIM
5. Why did he bring the *bikurim*? TO THANK יְהוָה FOR THE FOOD
6. Moshe was the great Jewish leader. Where did he talk to the Jews? IN THE DESERT
7. One thing Moshe told the Jews was the reason that Jews must study Torah. What is the reason Jews must study Torah even today? TO DO WHAT IT SAYS AND BECOME GOOD PEOPLE
8. If Jews study Torah, what will other countries say about them? THEY ARE BETTER THAN ALL OTHER COUNTRIES
9. Right after going into Israel, יְהוָה told Moshe to write the Torah. What did he write it on? TWELVE BIG STONES
10. In how many languages did Moshe write the Torah? 70
11. There were two mountains near the city of Shchem in Israel. One was Har Grizim and the other was Har Aival. יְהוָה told the older Levi'im to say blessings and curses. What is a blessing? SAYING THAT יְהוָה SHOULD LET ONLY GOOD THINGS HAPPEN
12. What is a curse? SAYING THAT יְהוָה SHOULD LET ONLY BAD THINGS HAPPEN
13. Here's an example of a blessing and a curse. The older Levi'im would say, "Blessed is the man who does not hate his mother and father." What was the curse? CURSED IS THE MAN WHO HATES HIS MOTHER AND FATHER
14. Another example of a blessing and a curse: "Blessed is the man who studies the Torah and does the mitzvot." What was the curse? CURSED IS THE MAN WHO DOES NOT STUDY TORAH AND DO THE MITZVOT
15. What word did the Jews say after hearing each blessing and curse? AMAIN
16. One reward יְהוָה promises the Jews is that if they study Torah and do mitzvot, He will give them enough of something so they can buy what they need and have a lot of time to study Torah and do mitzvot. What does He promise to give them? MONEY
17. If the Jews study Torah and do mitzvot, what does יְהוָה also promise to do to enemies who attack them? BEAT THEM
18. Also, people will have enough to eat, so they will have a lot of FOOD
19. Also, the Jews will give birth to many CHILDREN, and they will have enough meat because they will have many ANIMALS
20. This parsha also talks about the curses that יְהוָה will bring to the Jews of Israel if they don't study Torah and do mitzvot. One curse is that people will be hungry because there won't be enough FOOD

2 - QUESTIONS TO פרשת פי תבא / Parshat Ki Tavo

21. Another curse is that certain people will die young. Who? CHILDREN
22. Jewish people won't feel well. They will get very SICK
23. Enemies will attack the Jews. Who will win? ENEMIES
24. Jews won't know how to do the mitzvot properly because there won't be enough RABBIS
25. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Also, the Jews will "go into exile." What does this mean? THEY WILL BE FORCED TO LIVE IN OTHER COUNTRIES
26. When the Jews heard Moshe tell them about the curses, they got scared. What did Moshe tell them? TO STUDY TORAH AND DO MITZVOT
