

QUESTIONS TO פְּרַשְׁתַּי וְיִלְקָח / Parshat Vayaillech

1. When did Moshe talk to the Jews for the last time? ON THE DAY OF HIS DEATH
2. Was he allowed to go into Israel with the other Jews? NO
3. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Name the man who would lead the Jews in capturing Israel after Moshe died. YEHOSHUA
4. What did Moshe tell the Jews about their capturing Israel? THEY WOULD DESTROY THE PEOPLE LIVING THERE AND BE ABLE TO CAPTURE IT
5. On the day of Moshe's death, how many Torah scrolls did Moshe write? THIRTEEN
6. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Where did Moshe put all the Torah scrolls? HE GAVE ONE TO EACH OF THE TWELVE TRIBES, AND HE PUT THE OTHER ONE INTO THE ARON
7. The king of Israel had to read some parts of the Torah every seven years during what Jewish holiday? SUKKOT
8. Who had to hear the king read the Torah? ALL JEWISH MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN
9. Why did 'ה say that all Jews had to listen to this Torah reading? SO THEY WOULD REMEMBER TO STUDY THE TORAH AND DO THE MITZVOT
10. 'ה had told Moshe many times that he would die. Moshe tried to get 'ה to change His mind. Did 'ה change His mind and let Moshe live longer? NO
11. **EXTRA CREDIT:** How many mitzvot are there in the Torah? 613
12. The last mitzva (number 613) is that every Jewish man must write something for himself. Write what? A SEFAIR TORAH (Torah scroll)
13. Why can't many Jewish men write a sefair Torah? BECAUSE THERE IS A SPECIAL WAY TO MAKE THE LETTERS AND THEY DON'T KNOW HOW
14. If a Jewish man can't write a sefair Torah, what can he buy to do this mitzva? JEWISH BOOKS
15. What should he do with the Jewish books that he buys? STUDY THEM
16. Also, to do the mitzva of writing a Torah scroll, a Jewish man can do something in one. Do what? WRITE A LETTER
